

Declaration of War
Let's Go
Mark 1:12-13
1-17-21

Satan Attacked Jesus':

1. Identity.
2. Physical needs.
3. Emotional struggles.
4. Desires for us.
5. Relationship with the Father.

How Jesus Won Spiritual Battles:

I. Empowered by God's Spirit.

Mark 1:10 – “And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove.”

Mark 1:12 – “The Spirit immediately drove him out into the wilderness.”

Deserts are places of:

1. Dryness.
2. Disappointment.
3. Discouragement.
4. Discontentment.
5. Disillusionment.

Zechariah 4:6 (CEV) – “...I am the Lord All-Powerful...don't depend on your own power or strength, but on my Spirit.”

II. Engaged Satan with God's Truth.

Mark 1:13 – “And he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan.”

Matthew 4:3-10 – “And the tempter came and said to him...Jesus answered, ‘It is written’...Jesus said... ‘Again it is written’...Then Jesus said... ‘Be gone, Satan! For it is written’...”

Psalm 119:47 – “I find my delight in your commandments, which I love.”

Two Applications:

1. My weakness is God’s strength.

2 Corinthians 12:9 – “God said to me, ‘...my power is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore, I will gladly boast of my weaknesses...that the power of Christ may rest upon me.”

2. Deserts are for intimacy, growth, and training.

Hosea 2:14-15 – “...I will allure (Israel), and bring her into the wilderness, and speak tenderly to her. And there I will give to her - her vineyards.”

Mark 1:13 – “And He was with the wild animals...”

Tacitus wrote, “[Christians] were covered with the hides of wild beasts and torn to pieces by dogs.” (Speaking of Nero – 64-68 a.d.)

Mark 1:13 – “...and the angels were ministering to him.”

Luke 12:37 (NLT) – “The servants who are ready and waiting for his return will be rewarded...He himself will seat them, put on an apron, and serve them as they sit and eat!”
