Heaven, Sex and Marriage - Let's Go Mark 12:18-27 1-2-22

I. The Problem - Living Only for This World.

Mark 12:18 – "And Sadducees came to him, who say that there is no resurrection. And they asked him a question, saying..."

"Being a Humanist means <u>trying to behave decently</u> without expectation of rewards or punishment after you are dead." - Kurt Vonnegut

"<u>Human decency</u> is not derived from religion. It precedes it." - Christopher Hitchens

"Life has no meaning...<u>It is up to you to give it a meaning</u>, and value is nothing but the meaning that you choose." - Jean-Paul Sartre

"It's up to each of us to get very still and say, <u>This is who I am</u>.' No one else defines your life. <u>Only you do</u>." - Oprah Winfrey

Decency and definition.

John 14:6 – "Jesus answered, 'I am <u>the way</u> and <u>the truth</u> and <u>the life</u>. No one comes to the Father except through me.""

"Failure" is being successful in the things that don't matter.

II. The Proposal – <u>A Perfect God and Heaven</u>.

Mark 12:24-25 – "Jesus said to them, 'Is this not the reason you are <u>wrong</u>, because <u>you know</u> <u>neither the Scriptures</u> nor the <u>power of God</u>? For when they <u>rise from the dead</u>, they <u>neither marry nor are given in marriage</u>, but are <u>like angels in heaven</u>."

- **1.** There is a <u>bodily resurrection</u>.
- 2. There is no marriage or sex in heaven.
- 3. We will fully enjoy and follow the Lord.

III. God's Promise – <u>He is a God of Life</u>.

Mark 12:26-27 – "And as for the dead being raised, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the passage about the bush, how God spoke to him, saying, <u>'I am</u> the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?' <u>He is not God of the dead, but of the living</u>. <u>You are quite wrong</u>."

Growing Deeper This Week

- 1. Read Mark 12:18-27. What stands out to you?
- 2. Why do you think belief in life after death is still the majority opinion? (Ecclesiastes 3:11, Romans 1:19)
- 3. How prepared are you to give a good answer when your faith is challenged? What would help you be better prepared? When will you get started?
- 4. How did the law of brother-in-law marriage address issues important to the ancient Eastern culture? (Deuteronomy 25:5-6) In what specific ways can we address issues of widowhood and blessing those who have lost spouses?
- 5. What did you once believe heaven would be like? What do you know now and desire about heaven?
- 6. When Jesus debated the Sadducees, He used evidence from one of the five books of Moses because they only trusted those 5 books. How can His example give us a strategy to have discussion with people in our culture?
- 7. Which biblical description of heaven is the most encouraging for you?
- 8. Which biblical description of our new bodies in heaven encourages you?
- 9. Read Revelation chapter 21 sometime soon and praise God with heaven in mind.
