**OUR HOPE IS ANTICIPATORY:**

Isaiah 9:2 - *"The people who have walked in darkness have seen a great LIGHT"*

**I. Message of Hope = Light is Coming**

Isaiah 9:4 - *"Yoke...staff...rod...You have broken..."*

**II. Message of Hope = Oppression Will End**

Isaiah 9:4 - *"...as on the day of Midian"*

**III. Message of Hope = Unlikely Victory**

Isaiah 9:5 - *"Every boot of the trampling warrior...every garment rolled in blood will be BURNED"*

3. What does it teach us about God that He would choose to introduce Jesus in this way?

5. God speaks to His people through Isaiah, and He points back to a promise He made with David in 2 Samuel 7 (hundreds of years prior to this). What does this tell us about God and His promises?

6. How does it encourage you to know that God has always kept his promises?

7. Why is it important for us to remind ourselves of God's promises in difficult days?

8. How do the promises of God relate to the Hope that we have been talking about?
