# Facilities:

**General Maintenance** – Repairing and maintaining the church facility. The maintenance team usually serves on Tuesday mornings from 8AM-noon (or any time in-between there). Experience is helpful, but not necessary. Just a heart to serve.

Landscaping - Help with watering, planting, weeding, and trimming.

**Snow shoveling** – Assist in keeping walkways cleared during the winter months.

## **CHILDREN'S MINISTRY**

## Kingdom Critters:

<u>Walkers</u> – Interact with walkers through the age of two one Sunday a month during our 10AM Gathering. Assist with loving, singing songs, playing and reading Bible stories. This ministry allows parents to freely worship in our Gathering.

**Preschool** - Interact with children ages 3-5 one Sunday a month during our 10AM Gathering. Assist with loving, sing songs, read books, help with crafts, and engage in play. This ministry allows parents to freely worship in our Gathering.

**Leaders** will teach simple Bible lessons along with leading the craft or activity. All lesson plans will be sent during the week and supplies will be ready for you each Sunday.

### Kid Connection:

**K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade** children will experience a worshipful time of engaging music, Bible based lessons, and small group time including crafts and activities to reinforce the Bible lesson.

- Leader Lead our boys and girls in the large group Bible Lesson and activities/crafts that apply to the Bible lesson.
- **Assistant** Serve alongside other leaders to create a loving and uninterrupted learning environment. Enjoy interacting with the children, assisting with activities, crafts, Bible, etc.
- Audio/Visual Operate the sound system for music and videos.

<u>Hallway Monitor Team</u> – Provides a safe environment by dismissing preschool children at the end of our Gathering and keeping the hallway secure.

**<u>Registration</u>** – Welcome our church families and visitors with children and give computer generated name/security tags.

<u>Safety Monitor Team</u> – Provides a safe environment by monitoring the building, register late comers, page parents, and record the attendance in each classroom.

**Special Needs** – Having a heart to assist individual children with special needs. These needs could vary and can be explained in further detail.

<u>Visual Arts Team</u> – Creative individuals can utilize their artistic gifts for visual arts within the children's ministry.

\* Commitment for most Children's Ministry serving opportunities is one Sunday a month at our 10AM Gathering.

## Kids Alive Ministry

\* This ministry is pending School Approval for the 2022/2023 school year due to Covid restrictions.

An exciting ministry for school children (1st—5th Grade) in the public schools that teach children about the love of Christ. **Meeting once a month on a Friday with one practice per month for main leaders.** 

- **Assistant** Assisting with children 1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Skits Acting out Bible or other characters to emphasize the Bible lesson.
- **Puppets** Serving in a creative way using the puppet ministry.
- **Setup/Tear down** Setting up and tearing down for the monthly Kid's Alive.
- Audio/Visual Operating the sound system for music and videos.

# <u>M.O.P.S.</u>

**Mops Kids** is a ministry that provides childcare for children (Infants – 5 years old) while their moms are in our M.O.P.S. Ministry (Mothers of Preschoolers) meetings. M.O.P.S. meetings are typically held on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Fridays. (September–May) from 9:30am-11:30am.
