

**The King and His Passion**  
**Let's Go**  
**Mark 14:12-25**  
**3-13-22**

Isaiah 53:10 – "...It was the will of the LORD to crush Him; He has put him to grief; when His soul makes an offering for guilt, (but) He shall see his offspring..."

**I. His Supremacy.**

Nehemiah 9:6 – "You alone are the LORD. You created the heavens...with all their host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to all things, and the host of heaven worships You."

1 Corinthians 10:31 – "Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God."

**Mark 14:12-16** – "And on the first day of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, his disciples said to him, 'Where will you have us go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?' And he sent two of his disciples and said to them, 'Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him, and wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, 'The Teacher says, Where is my guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' And he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready; there prepare for us.' And the disciples set out and went to the city and found it just as he had told them, and they prepared the Passover.'"

Revelation 13:8 – "...(our names were) written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain."

Revelation 5:12 – "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive...honor, glory and blessing!"

John 1:29 – "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

1 Corinthians 5:7 – "Cleanse out the old leaven... Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."

Revelation 12:11 – "And they overcame...because of the blood of the Lamb...because of the word of their testimony...they did not love their life even when faced with death."

Revelation 6:16 – "...they said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb."

Hebrews 12:2 – "...looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."

1 Peter 1:8 – "...you love Him... you believe in Him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory."

## II. His Love.

**Mark 14:17-21** – *"And when it was evening, he came with the twelve. And as they were reclining at table and eating, Jesus said, 'Truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me, one who is eating with me.' They began to be sorrowful and to say to him one after another, 'Is it I?' He said to them, 'It is one of the twelve, one who is dipping bread into the dish with me. For the Son of Man goes as it is written of him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been better for that man if he had not been born.'"*

## III. His First Lord's Supper.

**Mark 14:22-25** – *"And as they were eating, he took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to them, and said, 'Take; this is my body. And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, and they all drank of it. And he said to them, 'This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many. Truly, I say to you, I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.'"*

John 13:14 – *"If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet."*

Luke 22:19 – *"...do this in this in remembrance of me."*

Galatians 2:20 – *"I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."*

### **Growing Deeper This Week**

1. What is the danger in saying, "Jesus was a good, well-intentioned man who thought He was the Son of God, but He was mistaken"? Couldn't we still learn from His example?
2. How does the way Jesus sending the disciples to find the upper room give evidence that Jesus oversaw the whole situation?
3. How does Jesus' control of events surrounding His passion week encourage you when you face difficulties?
4. What might the disciples have thought when Jesus said that one of them would betray Him? Do you think you would have suspected your own heart if you had been there?
5. In what way did all the disciples betray Jesus? In what way has every person betrayed Him and put Him on the cross? How can that betrayal be forgiven?
6. Why might the Last Supper also be called the First Supper? What did Jesus inaugurate?
7. What did Jesus mean by saying, "This is My body" and "This is My blood"?
8. How would you like people to remember you after you die? What would you want to be some of your last words?
9. Read about the great exodus in Luke 4:18-19 from a life of selfishness and sin. Pray for one another and take communion together.
