John 15:11 (NLT) — "Jesus said, I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!"

2 Corinthians 7:4 - "I am overflowing with joy in spite of all our trouble."

John 19:30 - Jesus said, "It is finished..."

IV. His Power. (Luke 24:49-53)
