I. God Reveals Controlling Idols. (Exodus 7:14-23)

Exodus 12:12 – "...and on the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments: I am the Lord."

II. God Destroys False Idols. (Exodus 7:12)

Exodus 7:12 – "For each man cast down his staff, and they became serpents."

Aaron's staff swallowed up their staffs."

Colossians 3:1-2 — "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things on the earth."

III. God Frees us from Idols by Giving Himself. (Exodus 7:17)

Exodus 7:17 - "By this you shall know that I am Lord."

Exodus 5:2 — "But Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice....?"

Exodus 9:14 — "For this time I will send all my plagues on you yourself, and on your servants and your people, so that you may know that there is none like me in all the earth."
