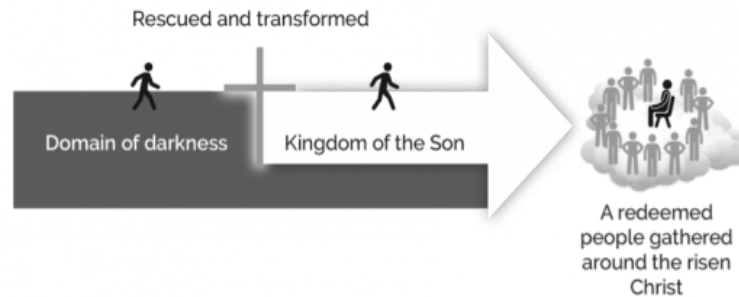


United in the Gospel: God's Wrath and Goodness
