I. Three Truths About Our Problems.

- 1. Problems are unavoidable.
- James 1:1-2 "...To the twelve tribes in the Dispersion... Count it all joy, my brothers when you meet trials..."
- John 16:33 "Jesus said, 'In this world you will have trouble..."
- 1 Peter 4:12 "Don't be surprised when the fiery trial comes upon you to test you..."
- 2 Timothy 3:12 "...everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted."
 - 2. Problems are unpredictable.
- James 1:2 "Count it all joy, my brothers when you meet trials of various kinds..."
 - 3. Problems come in all shapes and sizes.

II. What Problems Accomplish?

- 1. Expose my deepest joys.
- James 1:2 "Count it all joy, my brothers when you meet trials of various kinds..."
- Psalm 73:25 "...there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you."
- 2 Corinthians 1:9 "...(these troubles) were to make us <u>depend</u> not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead."

2. Purify my faith.

James 1:3 – "for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness."

3. Build steadfastness.

James 1:3 – "for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness."

4. Mature me.

James 1:4 – "And let steadfastness have its <u>full effect</u>, that you may be <u>perfect and complete</u>, <u>lacking in nothing</u>."

5. Cause me to seek His wisdom.

James 1:5 – "<u>If</u> any of you lacks wisdom, let him <u>ask God</u>, who gives <u>generously</u> to all without <u>reproach</u>, and <u>it will be given him</u>."
