1. Growth in loving God.

James 2:20-24 — "Do you want to be <u>shown</u>, you foolish person, that <u>faith apart from works is useless</u>? Was not <u>Abraham</u> our father <u>justified by works</u> when he <u>offered up his son Isaac on the altar? You see</u> that faith was active along with his works, and faith was <u>completed by his works</u>; and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, 'Abraham <u>believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness'</u>—and he was called a <u>friend of God</u>. <u>You see</u> that a <u>person is justified by works and not by faith alone</u>."

2. Growth in loving others.

James 2:25 – "And in the same way was not also <u>Rahab the prostitute justified by works</u> when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way?"

3. Growth in making disciples.

James 2:26 — "For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead."

Acts 1:8 – "You will receive power when the <u>Holy Spirit has come upon you</u>, and you will <u>be my</u> witnesses in Jerusalem...Judea...Samaria... to the end of the earth."

- 1. What are you thankful for this week? Read James 2:14-26. What is most meaningful to you in this scripture?
- 2. Explain the Gospel to someone in your group and later pray for one another to proclaim the Gospel this week.
- 3. How do you react when a person talks a lot but produces little or no fruit?

- 6. Read Romans 11:6 and 2 Corinthians 13:5. Share some reasons you know that you are a follower of Jesus. If not yet a follower, what is an obstacle for you to completely trust and follow Him?
