The Kingdom Let's Go Mark 1:14-15 1-24-21

Kingdom people:

I. Experience God's Kingdom Now.

Mark 1:14-15 – "Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, <u>proclaiming the gospel of God</u>, (Jesus was) saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the <u>kingdom of God is at hand</u>...'"

The Gospel is the King rescuing rebellious sinners—restoring us to enjoy being His sons and daughters who fight to end idolatry and injustice.

John 3:3 – "Jesus said, '...I say to you, unless one is <u>born again</u> he cannot <u>see the kingdom of</u> *God.'"*

Matthew 6:10 – "Jesus taught them to <u>pray, 'Your kingdom come</u>, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.'"

Matthew 6:33 – "Jesus said, 'But <u>seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness</u>, and all these things will be added to you.'"

Romans 14:17 – "Paul said, 'For the kingdom of God is not a matter of <u>eating and drinking</u> but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.'"

II. Value Time.

Mark 1:15 – "... The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand..."

Psalm 90:12 – "Teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom."

Ephesians 5:16 – "Make the best use of the time, because the days are evil."

Matthew 24:14 – "And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world... and then <u>the end will come</u>."

III. Continually Repent and Believe.

Mark 1:15 – "and saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; <u>repent and believe in the gospel.</u>"

"Repent" - A change of mind & heart that leads to a change of direction.

"Believe" - Trust, fully rely on.

Matthew 3:8 – "Bear fruit in keeping with repentance."

Those Who Repent and Believe:

1. Enjoy the <u>fullness of God's life</u>.

Psalm 66:18 (NLT) – "If I had not confessed the sin in my heart, the <u>Lord would not have</u> listened."

2. Are <u>listened to and trusted</u>.

1 Thessalonians 2:8 (NLT) – "We loved you so much that we shared with you not only <u>God's</u> Good News but our own lives, too."

The Gospel is the King rescuing rebellious sinners—restoring us to enjoy being His sons and daughters who <u>fight to end idolatry and injustice</u>.
