- 3. Why might the people in Jesus' hometown have resented Him? Is the response of a person's hometown and family a reliable indicator of whether the "prophet" is genuine and legitimate?
- 4. List some of the things Jesus said and did that are astonishing. Do non-Christians acknowledge that He said and did those things?
- 5. How is it possible for a person to see what Jesus did and yet deny that He is the Savior, the Son of God?

- 6. What kinds of credentials do you expect spiritual leaders to have? Are the most important credentials where they went to school, how well-spoken they are, who recommends them, or something else?
- 7. Should we avoid offending people when we tell them about Jesus?
