Questions for this week:

- I. For Starters:

 - 4. Where did John minister and why is this important? (see Matthew 10:5-6 and Luke 2:34-35)
 - 5. Read the other Gospel accounts of John's ministry of announcing the Messiah and see what you observe. Matthew 3:1-17, Mark 1:1-8 and John 1:15-42.
 - 6. John essentially was called to *declare* the way of Christ, *prepare* the way of Christ and *get out of the way* of Christ. How is your life and ministry like his?
