Caring Enough to Confront Luke 6:39-45

I.	Important	lessons on	helping	others	address	their	sins &	k short	tcomings.

- 1. We <u>must see clearly</u> in order to help others in their spiritual walk.
- 2. We must first Be what we want to lead others to Become.
 - Anger
 - Rebellion
 - Hypocrisy
- 3. We must have a consistency of <u>character & speech</u> in order to truly help others.

II. Observations concerning our refusal to accept correction.

Galatians 5:16-20 ... walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please.

... Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery...

....enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions,

When our flesh is in control we....

- 1. Resist being <u>corrected & exposed</u>.
- 2. Make up our own <u>standards</u>.

- 3. Become <u>defensive & justify</u> our self-centeredness.
- 4. Value being right, heard, understood & getting our desires more than <u>Christ-likeness.</u>

III. Skills to learn when confronting others in love.

- 1. Focus on common ground.
- 2. Go with humility & a clean heart.
- 3. Focus on behavior, not character.
- 4. Seek restoration & growth in Christ.

IV. Getting the most of confrontation.

- 1. Acknowledge thankfulness.
- 2. Agree with the truth.
- 3. Ask for more.
