- II. We must continually choose between the God who sets us free and the idols that will stronghold us. (Judges 2:7-15)
 - A stronghold deceives us to rely on anything other than God, causing bondage.
 - 1. Refuse Refuse the devil an opportunity.

Ephesians 4:27 - "...do not give the devil an opportunity."

2. Resist - Submit to the Lord and resist the enemy.

James 4:7 – "...submit to God and resist the devil and he will flee from you."

3. Ready ourselves - Be clothed with God's armor to take down strongholds.

Ephesians 6:11 – "Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil."

III. God's jealousy and kindness are our only hope. (Judges 2:14-23)

Psalm 91:2-3 - "I will say to the LORD, 'My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust! For it is He who delivers..."
