Jeremiah 15:16 - "...<u>I ate your words</u>, and your words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart, for I am <u>called by your name</u>, O LORD, God of hosts."

Hebrews 12:2 -"...for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."
