- I. Remember your identity. (Daniel 1:1-7)
 - 1. Isolation
 - 2. Deception

 - a. Created to be an image bearer.

Genesis 1:27 - "God created man in his own image...male and female he created them."

b. Redeemed to be His.

Isaiah 43:1 - "...He who formed you says.... 'Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!""

c. Chosen, holy and greatly loved.

Deuteronomy 14:2 - "For you are a people holy to the Lord your God, and the Lord has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth."

d. Called to be a servant of the King.

Psalm 119:125 - "I am your servant; give me understanding..."

II. Risk being Christ-like with your message. (Daniel 1:8-21)

Hudson Taylor - "Unless there is the element of extreme risk in our exploits for God, there is no need for faith."

1. Pray.

1 Timothy 2:1 - "I urge that...prayers...be made for all people."

2. Be humble and relational.

Matthew 7:12 - "So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them ... "

3. Do our work well.

Colossians 3:23-24 - "Whatever you do, <u>work heartily, as for the Lord</u> and not for men... You are <u>serving the Lord Christ</u>."

4. Offer options versus saying no.

Colossians 4:5 - "Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time."

5. Be clear with the Gospel.

Ephesians 6:19 - "(pray) also for me... to boldly proclaim the mystery of the gospel."

- 6. Read 1 Chronicles 29:13-14 and Luke 17:10. What is said about our true identity that could impact our daily lives and our responses to the praises of others?
