Exile and Return: "The God who Speaks"

Nehemiah 8:1-12

I. God's people <u>gather together around</u> His Word. (Nehemiah 8:1-2)

Deuteronomy 31:11-12 - "When all Israel comes...before the Lord your God...you shall read this law before all Israel... <u>Assemble the... men, women,</u> and little ones, and the sojourner within your towns, that they may <u>hear and</u> <u>learn to fear the Lord your God</u>, and be careful to <u>do all the words of this</u> <u>law</u>..."

1 Timothy 4:13 - "...<u>devote yourself</u> to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching."

2 Timothy 4:2-3 - "Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching...

For the time is coming <u>when people will not endure sound teaching</u> but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions."

1 Corinthians 1:21 - "...<u>God was well-pleased</u> through the <u>foolishness of the</u> <u>message preached</u> to <u>save</u> those who believe." II. God's people worship God based on His Word. (Nehemiah 8:3-6)

Worship is knowing, enjoying and proclaiming the worth of Jesus Christ.

John 5:39-40 - "You search the <u>Scriptures</u> because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is <u>they that bear witness about me</u>...come to me that <u>you may have life</u>."

III. God's people joyfully disciple others from His Word. (Nehemiah 8:7-12)

Acts 20:20 - "I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable and <u>teaching you in public</u> and from <u>house to house</u>."

1 Thessalonians 2:8 - "...we were ready to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own selves, because you had become very dear to us."

John 15:11 - "Jesus said, '...I have <u>spoken</u> to you, <u>that my joy may be in</u> <u>you</u>, and that your joy may <u>be full</u>."

John 16:24 - "Jesus said, 'Until now you have asked nothing in my name. <u>Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full</u>."

Romans 14:17 - "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of <u>righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.</u>"
