7 ways to fight for sincere worship:

- 1. Worship God based on the work of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 2:5)
- 2. Make all of life about worship (Romans 12:1)
- 3. Praise Him through song (Hebrews 13:15)
- 4. Gather with others (Malachi 3:16)
- 5. Remember the Word (Malachi 4:4)
- 6. Look for the work of the Lord (Malachi 4:5)
- 7. Repent for areas of insincere worship (Malachi 4:6)
