## The Rescue Begins: The New Birth John 3:1-21

We are saved by <u>grace alone</u>, through <u>faith alone</u>, in <u>Christ alone</u>, with the <u>word alone</u>, for <u>God's glory alone</u>.

I. Our New birth is Created by the Spirit. (John 3:1-10)

**Regeneration** is God's free and supernatural transformation inside all believers that is expressed by faith in Christ.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 - "And <u>I</u> will give you a <u>new heart</u>, and a <u>new spirit I will put within</u> <u>you</u>... I will remove the <u>heart of stone</u>... and <u>cause you to walk in my statutes</u>..."

Titus 3:3-6 - "For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient...<u>slaves</u> to various passions and pleasures... <u>he saved us</u>, not because of <u>works done by us in</u> <u>righteousness</u>...but by the <u>washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit</u> ... through Jesus Christ our Savior."

Ephesians 2:1-7 - "You were <u>dead in the trespasses and sins</u>... But God, being rich in <u>mercy</u>, because of the <u>great love</u> with which he loved us... even when we were <u>dead</u> in our trespasses, <u>made us alive together with Christ</u>."

2 Corinthians 4:4-6 - "...the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God... For God, who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness,' has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

Mark 3:27 - "But no one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first <u>binds the strong man</u>. Then indeed <u>he may plunder his house</u>."

Zechariah 4:6 - "Then he said to me, "...Not by <u>might</u>, nor by <u>power</u>, but by <u>my Spirit</u>, says the Lord of hosts."

II. Our new birth comes through <u>faith in God's Son</u>. (John 3:11-15)

III. Our new birth results in transformation. (John 3:16-21)

Effects of Knowing God Saved Us:

1. <u>Greater thankfulness for our salvation</u>.

1 Corinthians 1:28-31 – "<u>God chose</u> what is low and despised... <u>because of him</u> you are in Christ Jesus... <u>so... boast in the Lord.</u>"

## 2. <u>Confidence in everyday life</u>.

Romans 8:30,28 - "And those whom he <u>predestined</u>... <u>know that in all things God</u> <u>works for the good of those who love him</u>, who have been called according to his purpose."

3. <u>Passion to be Christ-like.</u>

Romans 8:29 - "For those whom he <u>foreknew</u> he also predestined to be <u>conformed to</u> <u>the image of his Son</u>."

4. <u>Evangelism becomes a joy and a priority</u>.

2 Timothy 2:10 - "Therefore I <u>endure everything</u> for the <u>sake of the elect</u>, that they also may obtain the <u>salvation</u> that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory."
