Stories and Signs: The Deception of Trusting in Ourselves Luke 18:9-14

Self-righteousness - Confident in one's own righteousness and the ability to produce righteousness by self-effort.

I. <u>Deceived about Jesus</u>.

"...the Christians say: <u>Messiah is the son of Allâh</u>. That is a saying from their mouths. They imitate the saying of the disbelievers of old. Allâh's Curse be on them, how they are deluded away from the truth." (Quran 9:30)

"The Messiah 'Iesa (Jesus), son of Maryam (Mary), <u>was (no more than) a Messenger of Allâh</u> and His Word..." (Quran 4:171)

"And because of their saying (in boast), "We killed Messiah 'Iesa (Jesus), son of Maryam (Mary), the Messenger of Allâh," – but <u>they killed him not</u>, <u>nor crucified him</u>, but the resemblance of 'Iesa (Jesus) was put over another man (and they killed that man)...They have no (certain) knowledge... <u>For surely; they killed him</u> not [i.e. 'Iesa (Jesus), son of Maryam (Mary)]" (Quran 4:157)
