Stories and Signs: "The Gospel that Breaks Chains"

Mark 5:1-20

John 17:2 - "For You granted Him authority over all humanity, so that He may give eternal life to all those You have given Him."

- 1 John 3:8 "The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil."
- I. Satan's gospel <u>isolates people and fractures society</u>. (Mark 5:1-5)
- II. Jesus overthrows Satan's control with the Gospel. (Mark 5:6-13)
- ~ Demonic *possession* Control
- ~ Demonic *oppression* <u>Attack</u>

1. Steals, kills and destroys

John 10:10 - "Jesus said, 'The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly."

2. Deceives

Revelation 12:9 - "And the great dragon...who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world..."

3. Accuses

Revelation 12:10 - "...the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God ."

4. Blinds

2 Corinthians 4:4 - "In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God."

5. Seeks to devour

1 Peter 5:8 - "Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour."

6. Stimulates Disobedience

Ephesians 2:2 - "...you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience."

7. Works through false teachers

1 Timothy 4:1 - "Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons."

8. Comes as an Angel of Light

2 Corinthians 11:13-14 - "For such men are false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light..."

1 John 4:4 - "Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

III. Jesus changes our lives in order to gospelize others.
