
Jesus Changes Everything: "Jesus Changes Our Message" Acts 1:1-14

- I. Jesus promises to give the Spirit to empower His followers. (Acts 1:4-5)

1 Corinthians 12:13 - "For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body... and all were made to drink of one Spirit."
