Lawrence Krauss: "You are stardust. You couldn't be here if stars hadn't exploded... The (elements) were created in stars. So, forget Jesus. Stars died so you can live."

Colossians 1:16 - "...All things were created through Him and for Him."

  - 1 Corinthians 15:49, 58
- 1 Corinthians 15:49 "Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven."
- 1 Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing in the Lord your labor is not in vain."
