1. God's Peace is for All Who Please God.

Luke 2:13-14 - "Suddenly... a multitude of the heavenly host were praising God... Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased!"

Romans 5:1 - "...we have been justified by faith; we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."

2. God's Peace is Abnormal.

John 14:27 - "Jesus said, ...my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives... Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

3. God's Peace is Attractive.

Acts 16:25, 30-31 - "About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God...the prisoners were listening to them... 'Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"...they said, 'Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved... and your household."

God's Peace is to be Shared with Others.

James 3:18 - "And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace."
