# The Story Begins : In the Beginning, God Created... Genesis 1:1-26 January 5, 2019

### God's Story:

- 1. Creation Explains how everything began.
- 2. Rebellion Explains how everything went wrong.
- 3. Rescue Explains how people can be <u>forgiven and reconciled</u> to God through Jesus Christ.
- 4. Restoration Explains how God will renew this world and <u>restore us to be His</u> <u>image bearers</u>.

# I. The Creator Created Everything (Genesis 1:1-2)

Marvin Lubenow – "I have no <u>ethical right</u> to use my superiority, achieved <u>purely</u> <u>by chance</u>, to <u>violate the rights of other animals</u>, who through no fault of their own <u>didn't evolve the same abilities</u>."

Charles Darwin – "I am determined to escape from design and a personal God at all costs."

Romans 1:20 – "For <u>since the creation of the world</u> God's invisible qualities--his eternal power and divine nature--<u>have been clearly seen</u>, <u>being understood</u> from what has been made, <u>so that people are without excuse</u>."

2 Peter 3:3 – "... in the last days mockers will come with their <u>mocking</u>, to <u>follow</u> <u>after their own lusts</u>..."

Hebrews 11:3 – "<u>By faith</u> we understand that the <u>universe was created by the</u> <u>word of God</u>, so that what is seen <u>was not made out of things that are visible</u>." *Hebrews 11:6 – "Now <u>without faith it is impossible to please God</u>, for the one who draws near to Him must believe that <u>He exists and rewards</u> those who seek <i>Him.* 

#### II. The Creator is the Only God (Genesis 1:4-8)

Isaiah 45:18 – "For thus says the Lord, <u>who created the heavens</u>...who formed the earth and made it... <u>'I am the Lord, and there is no other</u>."

Nehemiah 9:6 – "<u>You are the Lord, you alone</u>. You have <u>made heaven, the</u> <u>heaven of heavens</u>...and the host of heaven <u>worships you</u>."

#### **III. Everything Else is His Creation** (Genesis 1:2-30)

Acts 17:24-28 – "The God who <u>made the world and everything</u> in it, being <u>Lord</u> <u>of heaven and earth</u>... <u>gives to all mankind life and breath</u>...He made from <u>one</u> <u>man every nation</u>...<u>having determined allotted times and...boundaries</u> of their dwelling place...for <u>'In him we live and move and have our being</u>..."

## **IV. The Creator's Word and Joy Starts Each Day** (Genesis 1:3-12)

Psalm 90:14 – "Satisfy us in the morning...that we may rejoice...all our days."

John 17:17 – "<u>Sanctify</u> them in the truth; your word is truth."

Psalm 25:4 – "Show me Your ways, O LORD; teach me Your paths."

## V. The Creator's Joy is Expressed Each Day (Genesis 1:10-12)

Psalm 19:1 – "The <u>heavens declare the glory of God</u>, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork."

1 Timothy 4:4-5 – "For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving..."

Psalm 104:15 – "(God gives) <u>wine</u> to <u>gladden the heart of man</u>, <u>oil</u> to make his face shine and <u>bread</u> to strengthen man's heart."

1 Timothy 6:17 – "...God richly provides us with everything to enjoy."

Colossians 1:16 – "For by Him [Jesus] all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth...<u>All things were created through Him and for Him</u>."

Augustine - "During all those years [of rebellion], <u>where was my free will?</u>...How sweet all at once it was for me to be rid of those <u>fruitless joys</u> which I had once <u>feared to lose</u>...you drove them from me, you who are the <u>true, the sovereign</u> joy...(more satisfying) than all pleasure,...you...<u>outshine all light</u>...<u>surpass all</u> honor, though not in the eyes of men who see <u>all honor in themselves...</u>O Lord my God, my Light, my Wealth, and my Salvation." - Confessions, Chapter 9

- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 8:5-6. In what ways should knowing that God created everything through His Son affect our thoughts, emotions and actions regarding the Lord Jesus?
- 7. Respond in prayer and share something you learned with your family and others this week.
