The Story Begins: God Keeps His Commitment to Us Genesis 12, 15, 17 2-16-20

"Commitment is to bind oneself to a person or promise. This makes us all in and wide-open."

I. God Keeps His Covenant Commitment. (Genesis 12:1-3)

1. An <u>unconditional covenant</u> commitment is God binding Himself by His own promises no matter what the other party does or does not do.

Genesis 15:12-18

Ezekiel 20:6 – "The LORD says, '<u>I swore to them</u>, to bring them <u>out</u> from the land of Egypt <u>into</u> a land that I had selected for them, flowing with milk and honey...'''

Romans 8:28,29 – "...we know that for those who love God <u>all things work together for</u> <u>good</u>... For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be <u>conformed to the</u> <u>image of his</u> <u>Son</u>..."

2. A <u>conditional covenant</u> commitment depends on the faithfulness of both parties and is damaged if one or both break the covenant.

Deuteronomy 11:26-28 – "...I set before you...the <u>blessing, if you obey</u> the commandments ...the <u>curse, if you do not obey</u> the commandments of the Lord your God..."

John 7:17 – "Jesus said, 'If anyone's <u>will</u> is to <u>do God's will</u>, he will <u>know</u> whether the teaching is from God..."

Mark Dever - "Church membership signifies a church's endorsement of a <u>person's salvation</u>, a <u>commitment to one another</u> in mutual <u>Christ-like love and discipleship</u>, and a <u>continual</u> <u>responsibility</u> in each other's lives for the <u>purpose of the gospel</u>."
